THINGS TO NOTE:

- 🍂 **A non-refundable deposit of \$80 per person is necessary to reserve the retreat date.**
- 🍂 A twelve person minimum (which does not include the presenter) is needed to reserve a program date.
- 🍂 For a 2-3 day retreat a deposit of one-third of the total fee per person will be required one month prior to the reserved retreat date.
- 🍂 Final count of people is due five business days prior to the retreat.
- 🍂 Cancellation of individual retreatants may be made up to three business days (less non-refundable deposit) prior to start of retreat. Any cancellations made after the 3 day period will be subject to payment in full.
- 🍂 Payment of the balance is due upon arrival at your group retreat. Check, cash, Visa, MasterCard and Discover are all welcome. Make checks payable to Pumpkin Hollow Foundation.
