

Garden and Grounds Seasonal Position

Mid-May through August minimum – option to stay through September or October

Community Living with a taxable \$700 stipend per month

- Maintain Trails and areas around all cabins
 - Push mowing and weed-whacking
 - Leaf blowing
 - Raking and trimming bushes etc.
- Spring and Fall
 - Raking /blowing all lawns
- Assisting in splitting/stacking firewood
- Assisting with all aspects of organic vegetable garden under supervision of resident master gardener
 - Prep soil
 - Plant
 - Harvest
- During programs:
 - After meal cleanup (with staff and volunteers)
 - Help setting up chairs etc./preparing areas for program gatherings
- Experience with gas powered tools a plus
- Variety of short-term volunteers are typically available for team projects
